# Fundamentals of Law Practice Tiffany Roberts & Kate Gaffney-- Fall Semester 2017 Syllabus as of 11/16/17

Course Objectives: This course provides an accelerated transition to practice for law students by teaching fundamental knowledge, skills and values needed to begin a legal career in a wide variety of settings.

- (1) Students will learn how to handle a case from initial client meeting through conclusion of representation, first with a simulated case using on-line practice management software and in-class role plays, and then by representing actual domestic violence victims to obtain orders of protection in the Superior Court of Cobb County.
- (2) **Students will also learn about managing a law firm** through both classroom instruction and fieldwork with a private attorney working in a practice area of interest to them.
