The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

COREY WILL NELSON v. THE STATE.

Upon consideration, it is ordered that this case be placed upon the August 2021 oral argument calendar. A calendar will issue at least 20 days before the scheduled argument date.

Oral argument in this case will be a total of 50 minutes to be divided as follows: Counsel for appellant shall have a total of 20 minutes to argue in opening and rebuttal; following appellant's opening argument the Court will then immediately hear from neutral amicus curiae counsel who shall have 10 minutes to argue; counsel for the State shall have 20 minutes to argue; and counsel for appellant may use rebuttal time to respond to the neutral amicus curiae and to the appellee.
