
Four Component Model of Morality (FCM) (Rest, 1983)



Four Component Model of Professional Conduct (FCM)

Necessary Components of Professional Conduct	Operational Definition
Awareness	• ability to recognize ethical issues in ambiguous, real-life situations
Mature reasoning	• capacity to analyze ethical issues and provide well-reasoned justifications for decisions
Commitment	commitmen t to give priority to internalized professional values
Skill	• capacity for effective implementation and problem solving
